Report on survey at KVCTT by Thomas Winkler March 16th to March 24th, 2012

Community Members

In total 42 community members were interviewed, 29 of them were men and half of the interviewees were between 19-30 years old. It was my goal in every village to interview people which are directly connected to tourism, such as hoteliers or shopkeepers along the trek and those who are not directly connected such as farmers or community members with other occupations. Therefore, 22 of the interviewed persons can be considered as directly connected to tourism.

Almost 66% of the interviewed persons are taking actively part in NETIF such as attending meetings and trainings, joining cleaning campaigns or tree planting programs. However, it can clearly be said that hardly anyone knew about sustainable tourism or ecotourism; a few knew that it is a positive thing for nature and the locals. On the question about how much of the tourism income stays within the community the interviewees had different opinions – on average it can be stated that they think that about half of the tourism income will be spend in the community.

By looking at the table above it can be see that the overall rating of the project is quite good, especially for the answers about financial benefit (e), infrastructure improvement (f), environmental protection (o) and the overall satisfaction with NETIF (i). However, it seems that in some villages NETIF should provide more information (k) about their work and encourage people to think more about alternative energy (p).

The main inquires by community members were about more and longer trainings, also advanced trainings and most of them are hoping for a long-term cooperation with NETIF.

NETIF workers

In each of the four villages I interviewed the village coordinator and additionally two other NETIF workers. On average, they think that 25%-50% of the tourism income stays within their communities and that about half of the project's money is reinvested in environmental conservation.

As it can be seen from the table above the NETIF workers are satisfied with the project (g), they think the NETIF is contributing to environmental protection (m) and also increasing the awarness of environmental protection (o). They hope for more locals to work for and with NETIF (j) as the participation in the villages could be higher (k).

Overall the NETIF workers are very happy with NETIF's work and they are hoping for a long-term cooperation.

Tourists

In total 21 tourists from six different countries were questioned about their opinion of the KVCTT. Most of them stated that they are on the trail for trekking and getting to know the culture.

By looking at the table above it can be seen that most of the tourists enjoyed their stay at the KVCTT (b) and that their expectations were met (c). Almost all of them would like to learn more about the local culture (h) and get accustomed to local tradition (h). However, hardly any tourist knew about sustainable tourism in the area (d) or had knowledge about it (e). Therefore, it can be stated that NETIF should provide more information for tourists (g) as many did not even know that NETIF is promoting the KVCTT. Maybe this would lead to more contribution from their side such as donations or voluntary work (j).

Overall, there were compliments on the trail and the hospitality of the people in the area but many requested more information about the area and sustainable tourism.
